- Genealogical records are organized by geographical locality. Civil registration (government birth, marriage, and death records) and church records (christenings/baptisms, marriages, and burials) were kept at the **local level**. Court House Hotel 1869-1889

The *Court House Hotel* was situated on the corner of Faulkner and Beardy Streets, where the *Imperial Hotel* now stands


The first publican was William Gordon BRERETON, who stayed for 2.5 years before moving onto the *Wellington Hotel* (now known as the *Tattersalls*) in 1872.

The licence was taken over by Edward HODGKISS, who made extensive additions to the premises and had a large billiard room constructed. In 1875 he left Armidale with the intention to go to England but only got as far as Sydney and purchased a hotel there instead

Arthur Charles HAYMES was the next publican, but he abandoned the licence just a couple of months later. It was then taken on by William CANNING. However G QUINLIN was the owner of the building and advertised to sell it in 1881. Around the same time furniture from the hotel including 4 new safes, 4 new sofas, 4 new coaches and 4 new large cedar clothes chests were also advertised for sale.

James ROWLAND then became publican, but had left by 1886, when J B FITZGERALD was the licensee. By the following year Mrs LEVERETT had taken over.

The sketch below, drawn by Peter Chambers, shows the hotel on fire and people on the roof of the neighbour Post Office building



The current *Imperial Hotel* building was then constructed on this site.

The *Armidale Express* dated the 12 February 1889 recorded the fire that gutted the building. At 3.20 in morning of Monday 11 February Mr W M HARRIS, manager of the Bank of NSW looked out his residence window above the bank and saw fire bursting out from the neighbouring Singer sewing machine depot. The place was full of smoke and flames and the fire appeared to have a firm hold. Mr Harris immediately rushed for assistance while Mrs Harris called out 'FIRE' so as to arouse the neighbourhood. 'Despite all efforts on the part of the crowd, which soon assembled, another block of buildings in Beardy St was quickly burned to the ground. It comprised the Court House Hotel on the corner, Grey's tailor shop, Singer machine depot, Claverie's boot shop, Elliott and Solomon's mining exchange and Corpe's boarding house.'

'The *Court House Hotel*, owned by Mr David CREAGAN and only lately purchased by that gentleman was insured for £1,250 and the landlady, Mrs Maria Leverett had her furniture and stock insured for £700. As it got a good grip on the hotel, the fire sent showers of sparks onto and over the roof of the Post and Telegraph Office. With the shingles beginning to smoke a number of plucky individuals climbed onto the roof and with wet blankets managed to save that fine government building.'

Mrs Leverett then applied for a temporary transfer of the licence to the *Una Studio*, formerly occupied by H. B. Solomons, the photographer. However, operating out of temporary premises was obviously not successful and she left and took over the *White Horse Hotel*.


